


# Michigan Bolide and Meteorites




**The incoming trajectory was 21 degrees from zenith.**

On 16 January 2018 at 08:08:28 PM EST, the skies over southern Michigan were set ablaze (called a bolide) when a meteoroid approximately 2 meters in size ripped through the atmosphere.



**Todd Slisher's (Longway Planetarium) team recovered 8 meteorites. One of which was preserved in a freezer and arrived last week at JSC's Curation laboratory for further study.**



**Based on the final trajectory to the Earth, the meteoroid's orbit cross the paths of Earth and Mars**
