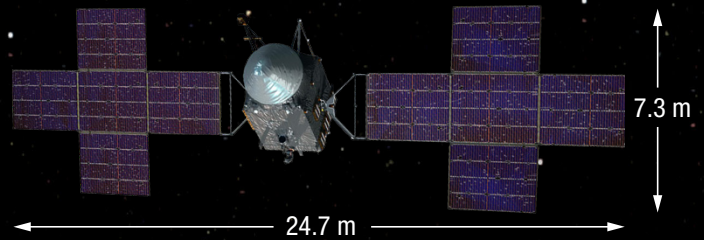




Make Your Own NASA Psyche Mission Spacecraft Paper Model

Psyche Spacecraft

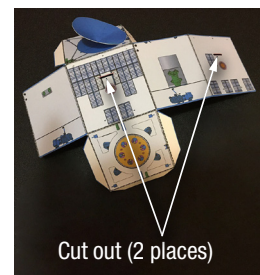
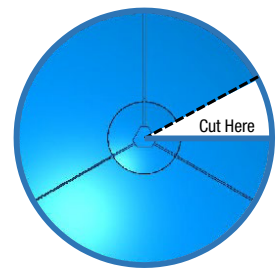
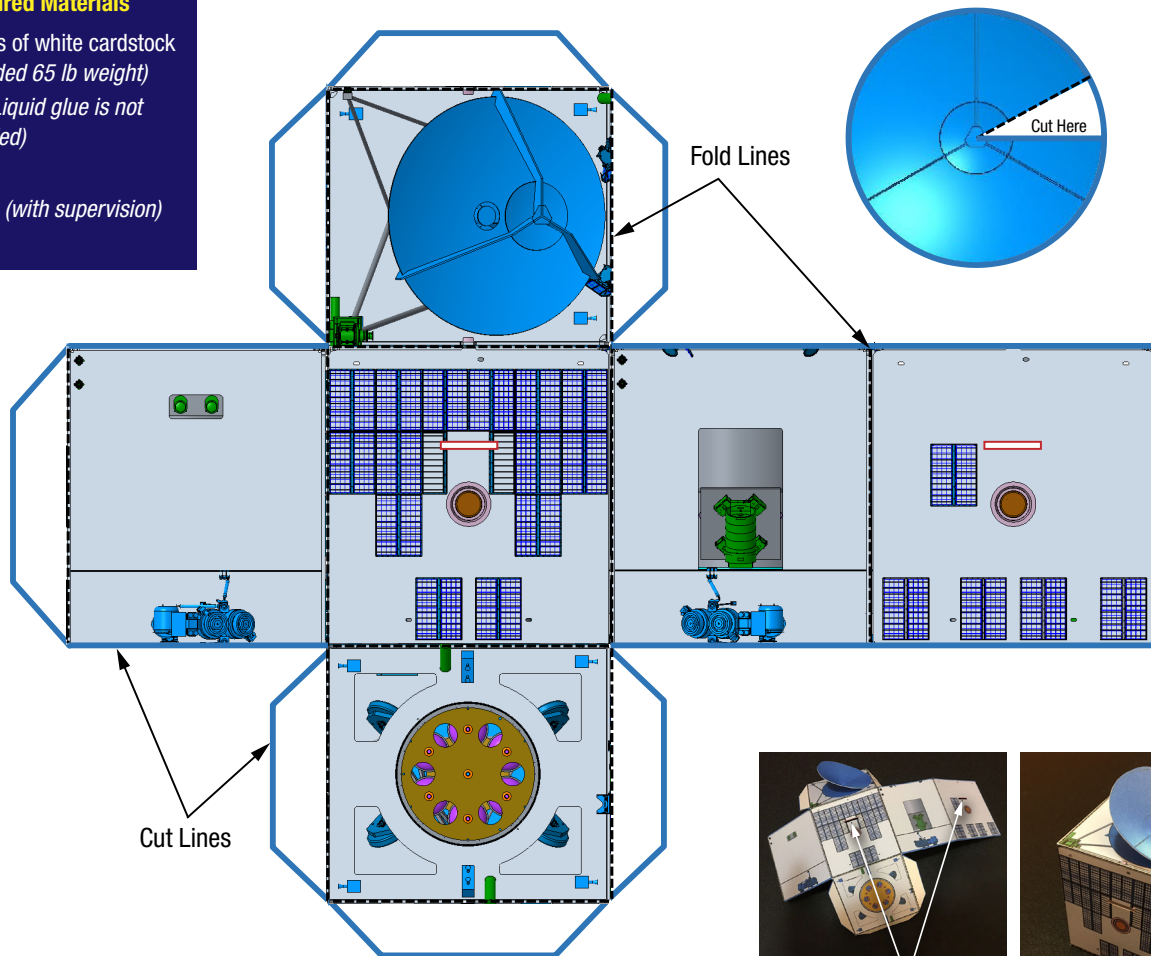


The full spacecraft, including the solar panels is about the size of a (singles) tennis court.
The bus (body) of the spacecraft is slightly bigger than a small van.

Print one copy of page 1 and two copies of page 2 of this instructional PDF in color on white cardstock. Use an X-acto knife or scissors (gently press to avoid cutting through) to score along all the dashed lines. Next, cut out all the parts, fold where indicated, and apply glue per instruction.

Required Materials

- Three sheets of white cardstock (recommended 65 lb weight)
- Glue stick (Liquid glue is not recommended)
- Scissors
- X-acto knife (with supervision)
- Ruler



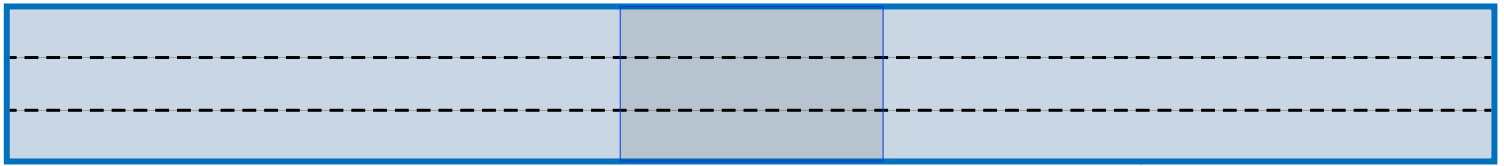
Cut out (2 places)
